

# ODNR agreement would add treatment plant positions

OCSEA and management in ODNR have agreed on the creation of a pilot program that would increase the number of qualified and certified water and wastewater treatment operators in the state parks. A proposed Memorandum of Understanding would create one full-time and nine part-time treatment plant positions.

Ballots and other information are being mailed to those eligible to vote on the MOU.
