

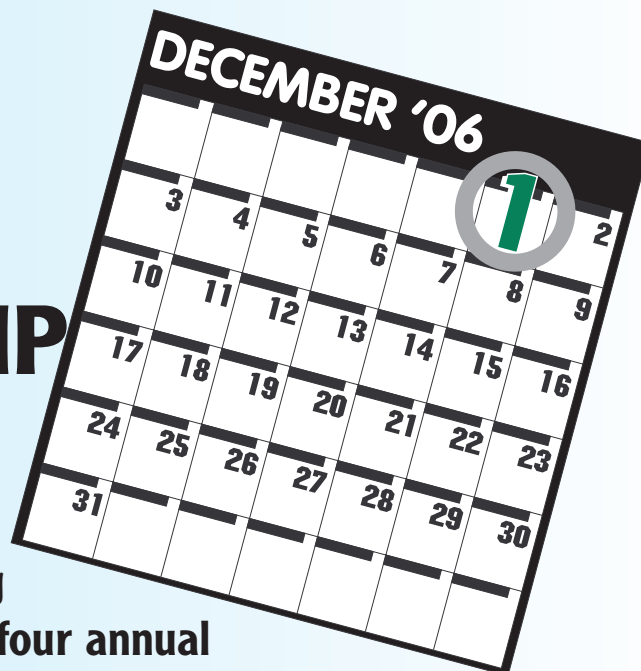

# Deadline approaches for the THE NADRA FLOYD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP



## Who was Nadra Floyd?



*Nadra, a dedicated trade unionist committed to her union, her family and the civil rights movement, passed away in November of 2001. The scholarship in her name honors her memory.*

The AFSCME Education and Leadership Training Department is offering four annual scholarships. These are open to all AFSCME members and staff who want to increase their leadership skills and obtain a degree from the National Labor College, George Meany Campus, Silver Spring, MD.

Twice yearly \$1,000 scholarships are offered to recipients to use for tuition, books, and room and board at the National Labor College.

Selections will be based on:

- an essay
- a letter of recommendation from your local union president or council director/president
- a letter of recommendation from a person in your community
- a confirmation of enrollment or approved enrollment to the National Labor College

Applications must be postmarked by no later than  
**DECEMBER 1, 2006.**

Award recipients will be notified by December 22, 2006.
