

## What's an Assembly?

**U**nion assemblies bring together bargaining unit employees from across the state that work in the same agency or department. Each chapter with members in the agency's **assembly** is entitled to send **delegates** to an assembly meeting.

Assemblies meet at least quarterly and are an important forum for strategic planning, as well as discussing and responding to problems in an agency. Although only delegates can vote at an assembly, meetings are generally open to any OCSEA member employed in that agency.
