In the event an eligible bargaining unit employee is laid off, that member retains eligibility for all educational assistance programs for up to one calendar year from their date of separation as long as they maintain their recall/reemployment rights.

Good to know...



“What happens to my UET benefits if I am laid off?”

Members displaced by recent layoffs are still eligible for the following:

- **Career counseling**, including career transition assistance
- **Career Improvement Program** – up to \$3,000 per fiscal year for tuition, lab fees, computer and technology fees.
- **Computer Applications Training** – up to \$750 per fiscal year (up to \$200 per course) for computer training
- **Professional Enhancement Program** – up to \$1,000 per fiscal year for short term training events such as workshops and conferences

Additionally, displaced members are also eligible to attend the **Aug. 8-9 UET Pre-Retirement Training**. The training program will consist of topics pertaining to financial planning, physical and mental health, social involvement, OPERS pensions and benefits, and overall wellness.
