EARLY VOTING BEGINS SEPT. 30



Want to avoid the crowds, long lines and bad weather that can sometimes come with Election Day? YOU CAN!

State law allows Ohioans to vote – by MAIL or IN PERSON – 35 days before an election without having to state a reason why.

Beginning Sept. 30, you can vote early by mail or at your local board of elections. However, election officials are pushing Vote by Mail as the best way to avoid long lines and other hassles.

Request an “Absent Voter/ Vote By Mail” ballot application by contacting your local board of elections or go to www.ocsea.org/vote for information on downloading an application.

DEADLINE “Absent Voter/ Vote By Mail” ballots must be returned to your county board of elections three days (*if not sooner*) in advance of Election Day.

This year’s deadline is Nov. 1 at noon.
