How do I get an
Absentee Voter
Application?

Can't make it to the polls on Election Day but still want your vote to count?

In order to vote
absentee, you
must complete an
Absentee Ballot
Application.

You can receive an application:

- 1 by visiting or calling your county Board of Elections.
- 2 by downloading the application online at

<http://www.ocsea.org/eaction/absentee.pdf>

- 3 by requesting a form be sent to you by contacting Sandi Kaufman (phone: 800-266-5616 ext. 2656, or locally, 614-865-2656 or by email: skaufman@ocsea.org).

Once you have completed the Absentee Ballot Application, mail it to your county's Board of Elections. They will review your application to make sure you meet the qualifications of an absentee voter. Once verified, they will send you an absentee ballot.

Deadlines for Applications:

Applications by mail must be received by your County Board of Elections by **noon on Saturday, Oct. 30.**

Applications by the voter **in person must be received by the close of regular board hours the day before the election.** Applications for **persons who are hospitalized by a medical emergency will be accepted until 3 p.m. on election day.**
