What is a Closed Drug Formulary?

A Closed Drug Formulary is a pharmacy benefit manager's approved list from which your doctor can prescribe prescriptions for you.



Is the Union considering this?

The Joint Health Care Committee is currently looking at the state's proposal to add a formulary to the Ohio Med PPO (most HMO's already have them) as a way to reduce health plan costs – which, in turn, helps hold down your health care premiums.

What if I need a drug that's not on the Formulary?

In those few situations in which your doctor feels you must have a medication that is not on the Formulary, in most cases, an exception would be made.
