Ohio must elect members to Congress – and a President who supports them – that will support benefit programs for Ohio's low income, unemployed and veterans.

On Nov. 4, elect politicians who will:

- ✓ Ensure the preservation of a state-run workforce development system and public labor exchange to serve all Ohioans.
- ✓ Fight against privatization that could result in a significant restructuring and elimination of many assistance programs administered by OCSEA members in ODJFS.
- ✓ Understand and support the need for a strong state role in the workforce development system and fight to protect and strengthen workforce programs, including the One-Stop system.
- ✓ Continue state fiscal relief to states that will prevent cuts to Medicaid services provided by OCSEA members in ODJFS.
- ✓ Support accountability in the provision of public services and review contractor abuse on the federal, state and local levels.
- ✓ End the erosion of valuable veterans' services and protect OCSEA members in ODJFS who staff these programs – many of whom are veterans themselves.
