

State employees must sign up for direct deposit by June 30



Beginning July 1, management will require all state employees to directly deposit their paychecks through electronic funds transfer.

Those employees who have not already done so will be required to complete an **Authorization for Direct Deposit of Pay** form identifying where they want their paycheck deposited **by June 30**.

For employees who fail to comply by this date, they will be required to sign an authorization to be issued a PowerPay card with a stored value on it that he or she can get cash or make purchases with. Only four transactions are permitted on the card before fees are assessed. Additional transactions will cost \$1.50 each.

Any questions regarding this matter or the PowerPay card should be directed to an employees' payroll officer.

The law regarding electronic funds transfer can be found in the Ohio Revised Code Section 124.151. Requirements can also be found in the OCSEA collective bargaining agreement under Article 36.09.
