Who was Les Best?

Les Best was an Ohio Civil Service Employees Association state officer and former math teacher at the Ohio Veterans Children's Home. Believing in OCSEA's dedication to improving the quality of life for its members and their children, Best felt an obligation to promote higher education and training.


In 1989, he proposed that OCSEA begin a scholarship for the children of active members and retirees.

Les Best died that same year, having served OCSEA for 10 years as an officer and 22 years as a member of its Board of Directors. Best was loved by many and his memory and dedication lives on through the Les Best Scholarship.



Application for the Les Best Members' College Scholarship

For active OCSEA members who are fulltime or parttime undergraduate students. Two \$1000 awards OR four \$500 awards for the 2017/2018 school year beginning in the fall.



Additionally, members submitting a completed Members' College Les Best Scholarship application will also be considered for one of two \$250 scholarships to be used for textbooks, made possible through the Pat Callanan-Castro Memorial Book Fund.

Thank you for your interest in the 2017 Les Best Scholarship Fund.

This brochure contains everything you need to apply for this scholarship. To be eligible for scholarship awards, qualified applicants must submit all required application materials. Use the checklist on this page to make sure you have all the requested requirements. You are strongly encouraged to write the required essay early to avoid getting "bogged down" near the deadline. The selection committee members report that they enjoy reading essays that include personal experiences in addition to ones that draw from historical data or current trends.

The Les Best Scholarship deadline is approaching. All required application materials must be received **no later than April 30, 2017.**

Checklist

Complete the application form

Include the requested last four digits of your Social Security number (OCSEA requires only the last four digits of members' Social Security numbers.)

Don't overlook No. 8 on the application: name and address of educational institution. We must have this information to send the award checks.

2. Submit acceptance letter or proof of enrollment for the Fall of 2017

If you haven't been accepted to an institution of higher learning yet, please give proof of application and estimated date of acceptance notification.

3. Submit an essay

Type a 500-1,000 word essay on white 8 1/2" x 11" paper on the following:

"The right to vote is a basic democratic right in this country. But some politicians have made it more difficult for some people to vote. What are some of the ways Ohio politicians have suppressed the vote in this state? Why are voter suppression efforts a danger to democracy? What are some ways to ensure that everyone's vote counts?"

The scholarship essays are a **major** part of the selection process. We encourage you to draw from personal experiences, using examples demonstrating how this issue would affect working families like your own.

4. Submit the Academic/Professional Reference form in this packet

Ask a person who can be a reference whether it be a boss you've worked for, your college advisor, or course instructor/professor to complete the **Academic/Professional Reference** form included in this packet. They may either return it to you to send in with the rest of your application materials, or they may send it directly to OCSEA.

5. Meet the application deadline All application materials must be sent to OCSEA Les Best Scholarship Fund 390 Worthington Road- Ste. A Westerville, OH 43082

All application materials must be post-marked **no later than April 30, 2017.**
